Available scholarships include:

- **AFP Member Development Scholarship** – for any non-AFP member employed by a qualifying 501(c)3 not-for-profit organization with an operating budget of \$1 million or less annually.
- **International Conference Chamberlain Scholarship** – for AFP members attending an AFP International Conference on Fundraising as a registered participant for the first time.
- **John A. Davis Scholarship** – for AFP members who are experienced development professionals, wanting to gain new or more in-depth knowledge in the field of fundraising.
- **Bill McDanel Endowed Scholarship** – for AFP members with less than five years of experience in the profession.
- **Certified Fund Raising Professional (CFRE) Application/Review Course Reimbursement Scholarship** – for AFP members who have demonstrated a commitment to the profession and are seeking to further their professional excellence.
