



2017 AFP Fort Worth Metro Chapter Scholarships

- 1) John A. Davis Scholarship** – for chapter members with 10 or more years in the fundraising profession who want to gain new or more in-depth knowledge in the field of fundraising.

Named after long-time Dallas-Fort Worth fundraiser John A. Davis, Jr., who was instrumental in the development of both the Fort Worth and Dallas chapters of AFP. The scholarship is to be used to fund advanced educational opportunities. It does not cover the AFP DFW Philanthropy Conference, AFP International Conference, Fundamentals of Fundraising, CFRE certification, the CFRE exam or chapter meeting expenses). Qualification: chapter members with 10+ years in the fundraising profession.

Deadline: November 15, 2017

Amount: up to \$750

- 2) James R. Holcomb Certified Fund Raising Professional (CFRE) Reimbursement Scholarship** – for AFP Fort Worth Metro Chapter members who have demonstrated a commitment to the profession and are seeking to further their professional excellence.

Named in honor of longtime Fort Worth fundraising guru James Holcomb, who has helped the Fort Worth Metro Chapter attain the highest percentage of CFRE's of any chapter on the planet.

Qualification: must register, pay, and then take either the CFRE Review Course or the CFRE Exam. After you have completed the course or exam, simply fill out the application form (found on the AFP Fort Worth Metro website) and submit request for \$250 reimbursement along with proof of payment. There will be four scholarships awarded in 2017. [Application Here](#).

Deadline: None,

Next CFRE Review Course offered May 18, 2017, Exam windows available throughout the year.

Amount: \$250

- 3) Bill McDanel Endowed Scholarship** – for AFP members with less than five years of experience in the profession to cover the cost of the annual Fundamentals of Fundraising course. Named in honor of long-time fundraiser Bill McDanel, a charter member of the Fort Worth Metro Chapter who helped develop the Certified Fund Raising Executive program and was one of the first fundraisers to achieve CFRE status. Qualification: A person in the fundraising profession less than five years. Register, pay and then take the Fundamentals in Fundraising Course. After you have completed the course, simply fill out the application form (found on the AFP Fort Worth Metro website) and submit request for up to \$350 reimbursement along with your proof of payment. **Deadline:** Aug. 15, 2017. Awardees will be notified by Aug. 30, 2017.

Amount: \$350 (the cost of the Fundamentals course)



- 4) DFW Philanthropy Conference** – is a scholarship that pays for registration to the Annual Motorplex’s most comprehensive fundraising conference, offered in spring by the Fort Worth and Dallas chapters of AFP. Information is available on the Conference [website](#).
- Qualification:** The scholarship is open to anyone, but preference will be given to members of AFP. Special consideration is given to individuals from organizations with limited funds available for training opportunities.
- Deadline:** March 15, 2017, winners will be announced on April 8, 2017
- Amount: Non-cash award is** Value of registration: \$135 - \$190
- 5) Fundamentals of Fundraising** – a registration scholarship (registration is \$350 for AFP members and \$450 for nonmembers) for the annual Fundamentals of Fundraising two-day course, which offers a complete overview of the development foundation and is sponsored by the Fort Worth and Dallas chapters of AFP. Qualifications will be determined by Fundamentals of Fundraising program committee. Applications may be completed on the same form as the registration for the Fundamentals of Fundraising course. - Qualification:** Professional fundraisers with up to four years of experience.
- Deadline:** Aug. 14, 2017. Awardees will be notified by Aug. 30, 2017.

- Amount:** Based on need and available scholarship funds.
- 6) Chamberlain Scholarship** – awarded to an AFP Fort Worth Metro Chapter member who has never attended the AFP International Conference that is held in the first quarter of the year. Funded by AFP Foundation for Philanthropy and the Fort Worth Metro Chapter. [Application Here](#).
- Qualification:** Chapter membership and having never attended the AFP International Conference.
- Deadline:** October 1, 2017
- Amount:** Covers all but \$10 of the registration fee to the International Conference (a \$585 value) and \$500 to reimburse travel paid by the Fort Worth Chapter. Recipient chosen by chapter review committee.

- 7) **AFP Ft. Worth Chapter DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP** – The AFP Ft. Worth Chapter offers one scholarship to the diverse community for the AFP International Conference.

Qualification: For a fundraising professional who self identifies as coming from an eligible diverse community as defined by AFP (African-American, Asian, Faith-based, GLBT, Hispanic, Jewish or Rural) or be a fundraising executive or professional or employed by an eligible AFP diverse community where 50 percent or more staff members are from that diverse community or a nonprofit organization that serves a 50 percent or more eligible AFP diverse community client base.

Deadline: October 1, 2017

Amount: \$1,500 Conference Registration Fee, reimbursement travel, hotel and meals.

- 8) **AFP International DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP** – The International AFP Foundation for Philanthropy offers one scholarship to each Chapter for an individual meeting diversity description. [Application Here.](#)

Qualification: The AFP International website details the qualifications. For a fundraising professional who self identifies as coming from an eligible diverse community as defined by AFP (African-American, Asian, Faith-based, GLBT, Hispanic, Jewish or Rural) or be a fundraising executive or professional or employed by an eligible AFP diverse community where 50 percent or more staff members are from that diverse community or a nonprofit organization that serves a 50 percent or more eligible AFP diverse community client base.

Amount: \$1,500 (Conference Registration Fee by AFP International plus reimbursement from the Ft. Worth AFP Chapter for travel, hotel and meals.)
